## **JOIN US SUNDAY, AUGUST 13TH TO HEAR OUR GUEST PREACHER DR. TYLER MAYFIELD**

We are thrilled to welcome Tyler Mayfield to the pulpit for both services on August 13th. The Rev. Dr. Mayfield is a professor at Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary where he teaches Old Testament and Hebrew.

Mayfield is also the faculty director of the Louisville Grawemeyer Award in Religion, a \$100,000 annual prize given jointly by Louisville Seminary and the University of Louisville for creative ideas that best illuminate the relationship between human beings and the divine.

A native of Town Creek, Alabama, The Rev. Dr. Mayfield previously taught at Union Theological Seminary in New York City, Claremont School of Theology in southern California, and the University of California, Riverside. He is a prolific author and frequent traveler to the Holy Land.

Mayfield writes for the website [WorkingPreacher.org](http://WorkingPreacher.org) and is the author of *Literary Structure and Setting in Ezekiel*, published in 2010. He is currently writing a book for seminarians and laypeople introducing the Bible's content. Additionally, he is working on a book entitled *Unto Us a Child Is Born: Isaiah, Advent, and our Jewish Neighbors*, which focuses on reading and preaching Isaiah through the lenses of Advent and the love of our Jewish neighbors.

Mayfield is married to the Rev. Lauren Jones Mayfield, who serves on the pastoral staff at Highland Baptist Church in Louisville.
