- 1 - washcloth
- 1 - wide-tooth comb (remove from package)
- 1 - nail clipper (nail clippers with metal files or emery boards attached are accepted, remove from package)
- 1 - bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 1 - toothbrush (in original packaging)
- 10 - Band-Aids or other adhesive bandage strips
