LAKESIDE SELF-STUDY COMMITTEE ANNOUNCEMENT

On behalf of the Lakeside Self Study committee, we are tasked with providing analysis and a report to session that will chart where God is calling our congregation and Lakeside Presbyterian Church into the future. This data will be used by our Pastoral Nominating Committee as they begin the search for our next pastor.

Our committee is focused on answering three important questions.
