STEWARDSHIP UPDATE – THROUGH JULY

We give to God out of gratitude; we glorify God through our gifts

We give thanks for what God has returned to us, Christ's church

We do God's will through Christ's church, our church, with the gifts God has returned to us

Summer is here, and as usual, giving has fallen behind expenses. The \$37K gap, or 11%, is at the high end of the range we typically see even through August. We fortunately have resources in place to manage this kind of cash flow gap. Our belief, our prayer, is that this shortfall is only temporary, and that giving will pick up pace in the Fall and in December.

Here's a challenge, or at least a thought. Wouldn't it be wonderful to welcome a new pastor early next year with a reserve of discretionary funds which could help us get started on the kinds of new and expanded Ministries our new pastor will work with us to initiate?

To do that, we of course need to first fill this year's gap. And we then collectively need to give more than what we might have anticipated at the beginning of this year, to establish some kind of reserve.

So, give what you can, when you can. But give out of gratitude, for everything we as a church have been, for what we are now, as well as in anticipation of what we can be in the future.
