#### PNC UPDATE

The PNC is continuing to make progress on the search for our new Head of Staff. We are now meeting weekly on Wednesday evenings and our meetings typically last 2.5 hours. Since our Ministry Information Form (MIF) was posted on the Church Leadership Connection website on September 4, our team has reviewed 45 Personal Information Forms (PIFs) from potential candidates. We had a video conference interview with one candidate on Wednesday, September 19. Additionally, we have made several requests to receive sermons to review from candidates as well.
