PNC Announcement! Save the Date: Sunday, March 24, 2019

Lakeside Presbyterian Church's Pastor Nominating Committee is pleased and excited to introduce Lakeside's new Senior Pastor / Head of Staff. The members of the PNC are very happy with the selection of this person and truly believe that God worked through the process to reveal the leader who was called to serve this congregation.

The candidate, following PC(USA) protocol, will be introduced and will preach the sermon at Lakeside on **Sunday, March 24**, during the 11:00 am service. This will give every member the opportunity to get to know the candidate. Immediately following the 11:00 am service, there will be a brief Congregational Meeting during which all members will be asked to vote on accepting the candidate as Lakeside's new Senior Pastor.

Over the past 18 months, Lakeside members have done the hard work of digging into who we are with a Self Study Report; others wrote a Ministry Information Form (MIF) to share this information with applicants; and we all elected a Pastor Nominating Committee to interview and screen applicants. The PNC met weekly, prayed and discerned. Arriving at this moment has been an arduous journey, but one taken with deliberation, joy and insight. The PNC paid close attention to the guideposts set out by the Self Study Report in its search. Several candidates said that they had never seen such a well-written MIF. Dozens of individuals deserve the credit for all the work that went into shaping the picture of Lakeside that was shared with applicants along the way.

One person rose to the top for this PNC, in virtually all categories. The PNC knows you will be pleased to meet the candidate. Details about the candidate's name and background will be released on March 21st.

If you have not been to service at Lakeside for several weeks, please plan to make the 24th the Sunday to attend. If you know someone who has been missing from the pew next to you, pick up the phone and give them a call. Invite them back to meet our new Senior Pastor. You and they won't be disappointed. If you need a ride to church that day, the Deacons are arranging them. Contact them at deacons@lakesidechurch.org to set up a ride.

There will be a reception on the morning of Sunday, March 24th, from 9:00 to 10:15 am to give you a chance to meet the new Head of Staff before the 11:00 am service.
