
PER CAPITA FOR 2019

Please note that 2019 started with a deficit of \$37,481.29

We had a great January. Even though we started nearly \$37,500 in the hole, giving nearly doubled expenses that month. March was another good month, with giving exceeding expenses by \$1,800. However, February, April, May, and June happened, and expenses exceeded giving in all four of those months. At mid-year we have added about \$2,100 to the deficit. Session committees have been asked to delay any purchases they can until giving picks up again after the summer. For those of you who have continued your level of giving into the summer, thank you! For those members considering contributions, or increasing their level of giving, now is a great time to start.
