**Kelly Haney** (soprano) is a Cincinnati native who began her musical journey at the Cincinnati School for Creative and Performing Arts. After graduating from S.C.P.A. she received her Bachelor's degree in Music Education from Bowling Green State University. Mrs. Haney began her teaching career at Five Towns College, Long Island, New York, where she was a private vocal instructor, artist in residence and sight reading professor. Currently, Mrs. Haney sings with the Armstrong Chapel Choir in Indian Hill. She has frequently soloed for the Northern Kentucky Community Chorus, and the Cincinnati Chamber Orchestra. Recently, Mrs. Haney has performed with the Clermont Chorale, Cincinnati Ballet, May Festival Chorus, Cincinnati Choral Society, Ensemble Con Fuoco, St. Peter in Chains Choir, and Athenaeum Chorale. She is married to Stacy Wm. Haney and they have three girls.

**John Ray** (flute) grew up in New Jersey and fell in love with the flute through video games and TV music, which led him to obtaining his Bachelor of Music in Flute performance in 2020 from the Hartt School in CT. Once the pandemic came around, he moved out to Cincinnati to be with his partner, Sarah, who is pursuing a Doctorate in Oboe Performance. In the fall of '23 John plans on attending the Longy School of Music in Cambridge, MA where he will be studying with acclaimed soloist, Sooyun Kim and has earned a Teaching Assistantship in Longy's El Sistema inspired student mentorship program.

**Chloe Basel** (oboe) holds a Masters degree from CCM in oboe, having studied under Mark Ostoich. Chloe performs regularly with the Lima Symphony Orchestra, the Cincinnati Wind Band, and in various other locations around the Tristate area. When not performing, Chloe works at the Aronoff Center in downtown Cincinnati, and enjoys baking homemade bread during free time, as well as reading and writing.

**Dr. Alice Ann O'Neill** (cello) is a professional cellist performing in orchestras, chamber music and as a soloist since 1985. She recently retired after 25 years of teaching at universities in Ohio and currently teaches cello in Cincinnati. Dr. O'Neill is a teacher trainer for the Suzuki Method and proud Suzuki Cello teacher in partnership with Louisa and Hugh Umphres. She is a Catholic nun and member of the Sisters of Charity.

**Jackie Davis** (harp) is an active harpist and teacher in the greater Cincinnati area. She often performs with the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra, as well as Cincinnati Chamber Orchestra, Blue Ash-Montgomery Symphony Orchestra and Southwest Ohio Philharmonic. Jackie maintains a busy freelance schedule, as well as a busy teaching schedule. She serves as an adjunct harp instructor at Miami, Cedarville, and Xavier Universities, and teaches privately at home and at the School for Creative and Performing Arts.

**Luke Myers** (glockenspiel) is an aspiring music educator and performer studying at Northern Kentucky University for a Bachelor's in Music Education. He currently studies and takes lessons under Michael Culligan, a member of the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra. He has worked with a couple of groups in the Northern Kentucky area such as the Ryle High School Marching band and is working as a Teachers Assistant of the Youth Symphony Orchestra run through NKU's Music Prep Department.

**Steve Popovich** (timpani) earned his music degree from the University of Kentucky. He played with the Lexington Philharmonic during his college years then moved to Pensacola Florida, as Principal timpanist/percussionist for the Pensacola Symphony Orchestra. At the same time he was performing nightly as house percussionist/drum set performer for the renowned Seville Quarter establishment in Pensacola, Florida. He joined the faculty at the University of West Florida and Pensacola Junior College as adjunct percussion instructor. One of his most memorable accomplishments and performances was with the nationally acclaimed organist with the New York Philharmonic, Leonard Raver. He has performed with the Northern Kentucky Symphony Orchestra and is currently principal timpanist with the Florence Community Concert band.

**Thom Miles** (organ) is the Organist at Lakeside Presbyterian Church and has been with us since 2003. Prior to coming to Lakeside, Thom was the Asst. Organist at Christ Church Cathedral, Cincinnati and also served as the Organist/Director of Music at Isaac M. Wise Temple for 30 years. We are so fortunate to call him ours!
